- **Frameworks at Identifying and Eroding Security Threats:** Scenario gaming exercises at practicing 'Situational Awareness', the 'Crime Matrix', 'OODA Cycle' and 'Risk Management Matrix'.

The training methodology emphasizes learning through a combination of lecture and scenario based exercises. This involves participants sharing with the security expertise of the consultant and equally important, experiences of their peers.
